16. Pouilly Fume Domaine Bonnard 2013, abv 13%

£36.50

Green apples, grapefruit, white flowers on the nose. Distinct stone and steel palate with lime and apple finish.

Burgundy

17. St Veran Les Deux Moulins, Macon, Louis Latour 2015, abv 13%

£38.00

Fresh nose with white fruits. This wine is round and rich on the palate, with aromas of pear and fig with a nice freshness.

18. Chablis, Domaine Long-Depaquit, Albert Bichot 2015, abv 12.5%

£36.00

An abundant and generous wine. You will enjoy the green and yellow tints which characterise Chablis. Its aroma and its flavour develop rather rapidly.

19. Limousin Verdedjo Reserva Marques de Riscal 2014, abv 13.5%

21. Chateau du Moulin, Languedoc 2009 £32.00

22. Chateauneuf du Pape, Vignoble Fabre 2009, abv 14.5% £45.00

Outstanding Chateauneuf from an immaculate property. A wine with power, finesse, and sensual persuasion. Made with great passion.

23. Woodstock Shiraz 2012, abv 13.5% £36.00

A deep vibrant cerise colour with some youthful purple hues. Mint and spice Aromatics belie the full but velvety smooth lingering palate.

Chile

24. Santa Ema, Merlot Reserva, Maipo Valley 2012, abv 13.5% £34.00

Very fruity wine with spices aromas of plums, blackberries and accompanied by intense notes of caramel and vanilla.

Italian

25. Chianti Classico, Castellare, 2016, abv 13% £45.00

Aromas and flavours of cherries, plums, spices, tobacco and liquorice. The finish is energetic and minerally.

Lebanon

26. Jeune Red, Chateau Musar, Bekaa Valley 2013, abv 14% £35.00

Nose of blueberries, violets, cherries. Palate is fresh and fruity with hints of redcurrants and plums, enjoy in its youth
